- Explain how you feel about 'being restrained saved your life and/or the lives of other occupants' in the vehicle.
- Why you decided to wear your seat belt.
- Did you or others sustain any injuries during the crash?
- If you wish, please share any milestones you have encountered since the crash (graduation, marriage, becoming a grandparent, etc.)
